## Minutes of a Meeting of Normanton Town Council

### 161. Mayors Announcements

In the absence of the Mayor, the Deputy Mayor chaired the meeting.

The Town Clerk reported that the Mayor would be hosting a Coffee Morning on 31<sup>st</sup> March and a Civic Service on a date to be confirmed.

The Mayors Chaplain led the Council in prayers.

### **162.** Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received on behalf of Councillor C Appleyard, Councillor D Appleyard, Councillor A Moran, Councillor R Seal and Councillor A Wood.

### **163.** Declarations of Interest

RESOLVED that the following declarations be received:

Councillor E Blezard Non-Pecuniary Interest – Planning Member of WMDC Planning Committee

Councillor W Wood Non-Pecuniary Interest – Planning Relative has submitted a planning application.

### 164. Members of the Public

There were twenty-eight members of the public present to speak on the Taylor Wimpey proposal.

No questions or comments were raised on any other matters.

### 165. Guest Speaker – Taylor Wimpey

Two representatives from Taylor Wimpey were in attendance to inform the Town Council of their proposals and to take back any feedback.

The development at Station Road would feature 408 homes (2-4 bedroom) and would be accessed from Station Road. There would be no access from the Wharfedale Drive area. The site included large areas of public open space and a lower density than is required. There would be 10% affordable housing in line with the new policy.

RESOLVED that the Town Council suspend Standing Orders to enable public participation on this item subject to a maximum of 30 minutes.

Altofts Community Action Group asked for the Council to support their campaign and oppose the development of this area. The reasons for the opposition to the development are:

- The proposal joins together the two settlements of Normanton and Altofts and takes away the character of the village.
- The development would take seven years to complete.
- Seven years of heavy traffic coming out onto Station Road and going through Normanton.

- The Local Plan 2036 had not yet been adopted.
- The consultation by Taylor Wimpey had only delivered a small number of leaflets.
- The Action Group leafleted the entire village themselves to ensure that people were aware.
- Residents tried to object to the Local Plan and were told they were too late.
- The consultation was carried out during Covid.
- Local residents have obtained over 2,000 signatures on a petition against the development.
- The MP objected in November 2020.
- WMDC have said that Normanton Town Council didn't submit their objections in time.
- LP45 should be taken out of the plan to enable proper consultation.

Residents raised the following points:

- The infrastructure in Altofts is severely lacking
- Altofts is already gridlocked by traffic
- Untreated sewerage is being discharged into the river and the sewers can't cope.

Taylor Wimpey confirmed that they had carried out two consultations and there will be further opportunities to provide feedback once the planning application goes in. The application would be determined after the Local Plan 2036 has been approved.

Residents queried the traffic data and asked if it took new developments into consideration. It was reported that it was an accumulative assessment to take into consideration the new developments and the Council (WMDC) have done the same tests.

In response to comments about lack of infrastructure, Taylor Wimpey said that appropriate contributions would be made through Section 106 agreements.

Taylor Wimpey were asked if there was any positive feedback for the development and if the redacted feedback forms could be shared with the Town Council.

Members of Normanton Town Council were supportive of the comments made by residents and confirmed that the Council had objected to the original consultation in 2019.

Extract from Minutes of Normanton Town Council – 12<sup>th</sup> February 2019.

### LP45 Land at Altofts Hall Farm, Altofts

This site would be an over development of the area which has already seen massive growth in recent years. The local infrastructure cannot cope with the addition of more houses. There is already a shortage of appointments at GP surgeries and school places. The highway network could not cope with additional traffic and the site is very close to a local primary school. Members feel that this proposal would change the nature of the village of Altofts.

It was suggested that further consideration would be given once the planning application is submitted to WMDC.

The Altofts Community Action Group asked what support the Town Council could give to further the groups aims in opposing this proposal. It was suggested that this could be discussed in more depth at the next meeting.
