Singers in reception area.

Things to improve:

More sweet bags;

Moving the Dance Display to Haw Hill Park;

Normanton Knightingales has requested permission to dance again in 2019 – Agreed.

The budget up to 31st October showed a saving of £124.72.

Things that didn't work well:
