Types of Stalls Available:

These terms and conditions are for the car boot sale on Gala Sunday, in which only the sale of second-hand goods is permitted.

If you wish to trade with new goods or crafts, then you must read the stall holders terms and conditions and book in using the events booking form.

Booking is NOT required for the car boot sale.

Number of Stalls Available:

There will be a maximum of 80 car boot sale pitches available at this event.

What will be Provided:

Each car boot trader will be provided with one pitch, wide enough to park their vehicle and open their door.

If you require additional space to the side of your car, you will need to pay for an additional pitch. If you wish to park sideways, you will need to pay for an additional pitch.

Charges:

The charges for the car boot sale are £10.00 per pitch.

All proceeds go to the Mayor's Appeal which is supporting local good causes.

Payment of Fees:**Payment on the Day**

Cash – Exact change is preferred.

Contactless – Subject to sufficient mobile data coverage – we will accept payment by contactless.

What can be Sold:

The car boot sale is for the sale of second-hand goods only.

No trader shall sell any item that contravened and of the following or similar associated legislation - Trade Descriptions Act 1968, Video Recordings Act 1984, Copyright Designs & Patents Act 1998, and the Trademarks Act 1994

Car boot traders must not sell any of the following items: counterfeit goods, herbal highs, tobacco, banned substances, pornographic or obscene material, disposable barbeques, any form of flammable equipment including fireworks and Chinese lanterns, nitrous oxide canisters, lasers, cap bombs, lethal, real, replica or toy guns.

Toys should bear the CE mark.

Car boot traders must not promote any political party or campaigning group during the event.

The Town Council reserves the right to remove from sale anything that can be deemed as unsuitable for a family event.

Licensing and the Sale or Supply of Alcohol:

Alcohol must not be sold from Car Boot stalls.

Stall Equipment:

Car boot traders must not use professional market stall equipment at this event.

Insurance:

Normanton Town Council does not provide any insurance for your attendance at this event.

You are responsible for assessing risks and ensuring that your vehicle and stall is safe.

Normanton Town Council accepts no liability for any loss, damage, or injury in connection with the event.
