

Wireless CCTV options won't interfere with the structure of the building but are capable of capturing images that can assist in the prevention of crime and enhance the safety of our staff.

A policy for the use of CCTV would need to be adopted to comply with data protection rules.

Costs:

Quotes would need to be obtained.

Budget:

The costs of the supply and installation could be met from the Town Hall maintenance budget if sufficient surplus is available. Alternatively, with the consent of the Finance Committee, the general reserve could be used.

Recommendation:

That the Property Committee resolves to support the proposal and obtain quotes for the installation of wireless CCTV cameras.
